## **BIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT**

Born March 28, 1917 in Jersey City, NJ, I studied art in Berlin, Germany, where my family lived from 1929 until Hitler's election as German Chancellor in January 1933, and then in New York City at The National Academy and The Art Students League of New York. Driven by the need to support myself and my family, I pursued a successful shoe design career for 44 years. Initially hired in 1935 as the first woman shoe designer at I.Miller, I started and operated my own design and manufacturing businesses (*Simone Fine Shoes to Match* and *Simone Fine* Shoes) in New York and Italy in the 1950s and 1960s. I have continued to paint throughout the nearly 10 decades of my life, but I was not able to devote myself exclusively to it until after the death of my husband, for whom I was full-time caregiver for more than a decade in the1970s and 1980s. I have begun to promote and exhibit my work only very recently, through a website displaying images of works created from the 1930s to the present (<a href="https://www.hspicker.com">www.hspicker.com</a>) and through two exhibitions scheduled in 2012/13. My commitment to making art remains undiminshed and I continue to paint every day with passion and joy.
